## Canine Good Citizen:



### **Canine Good Citizen Test REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1) Dogs MUST be old enough to have received necessary immunizations such as rabies vaccines, and there's no age limit for taking just the CGC test. Mixed breeds are welcome!
- 2) Bring your dog's grooming brush with you.
- 3) Have your dog on a six-foot leash (NO retractable leashes).
- 4) Have either dog license or AKC Registration number.
- 5) Dogs MUST wear either a buckle or training collar (NO prong or pinch collars - NO head halters, i.e., Gentle Leader, Halties).
- 6) During the testing, NO treats or toys will be allowed.

# AKC TRICK DOG

## TRICKS CHECKLIST: NOVICE



**Instructions:** Include this page with the AKC Trick Dog Title Application.

A TOTAL OF **10 TRICKS** ARE REQUIRED TO EARN THE AKC NOVICE TRICK DOG TITLE.

If you have a Canine Good Citizen (CGC) certificate or title on record at AKC, you may count the CGC as 5 of the required tricks for the **NOVICE TRICK DOG TITLE**.

### CGC Skills

#### Foundation Behaviors for Trick Training

1. Accepts friendly stranger
2. Sits politely for petting
3. Appearance and Grooming
4. Out for a Walk
5. Walking through a crowd
6. Sit, Down, Stay in place
7. Coming when called
8. Reaction to another dog
9. Reaction to distractions
10. Supervised Separation

CGC is on record (counts as 5 tricks). 5 additional tricks have been observed by evaluator and are checked below.

- \_\_\_ Balance beam (walk on board a few inches off floor)

- \_\_\_ High five
- \_\_\_ Hold (3 seconds)
- \_\_\_ Jump (thru a low hoop or over a low bar)
- \_\_\_ Kennel up (go in crate, stay in until released)
- \_\_\_ Kiss (point to cheek or back of hand)
- \_\_\_ Paws up (2 front paws on low stool or step)
- \_\_\_ Push-ups (sit, down, sit, down, sit, down)
- \_\_\_ Shake hands
- \_\_\_ Spin in circle
- \_\_\_ Touch it (hand or target stick)
- \_\_\_ Tunnel (agility tunnel or child's tunnel)

# AKC TRICK DOG



## TRICKS CHECKLIST: INTERMEDIATE

**Instructions:** Include this page with the AKC Trick Dog Title Application.

A TOTAL OF **10 TRICKS** ARE REQUIRED TO EARN THE INTERMEDIATE TRICK DOG TITLE. Must have the Novice Trick Dog Title; CGC is not required. No more than 2 Handler's Choice tricks (optional). Tricks must not have been previously submitted for Novice.

10 Intermediate tricks have been observed by evaluator and are checked below.

- \_\_\_ Balance treat on nose or head (e.g., dog biscuit)
- \_\_\_ Carry (such as basket or another object)
- \_\_\_ Catch (soft toy, soft ball, treat, etc.)
- \_\_\_ Crawl (dog on belly, crawls at least 5 feet-may use food or toy lure)
- \_\_\_ Fetch it (20 ft. away and deliver to hand)
- \_\_\_ Game (dog manipulates interactive canine game or treat dispensing item - puzzle, Kong, etc.)
- \_\_\_ Go find (handler hides, dog goes and finds)
- \_\_\_ Go to your place (to bed/mat, crate from 10 ft.)
- \_\_\_ Hand signals (Sit, down, come, stand. Total of 3.)
- \_\_\_ Jump through handler's circled arms or over handler's leg
- \_\_\_ Leg weave (weave around handler's legs)
- \_\_\_ Paws up (on handler's arm)
- \_\_\_ Pull a toy on a string or rope
- \_\_\_ Push button/key to make sound (e.g., sound toy, noise button, etc.)
- \_\_\_ Rollover
- \_\_\_ Shell game ("Find it" - find treat or scent item under 1 of 3 cups)
- \_\_\_ Sit pretty (sit up or sit w/ head tilted)
- \_\_\_ Wave good-bye/hello
- \_\_\_ Weave poles (may use food or toy lure to guide dog through 6 weave poles)
- \_\_\_ Wobble board
- \_\_\_ Other: Handler's choice #1: \_\_\_\_\_

*Ideas for Handler's Choice: balance ball, close/open door, ring doorbell, run and get ball from flyball box, remove object from box/mailbox, teeter totter (agility equipment), heeling with an automatic sit, head down.*

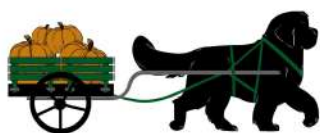
In Intermediate, handlers may not use lures unless specified, but may use food rewards or clickers.

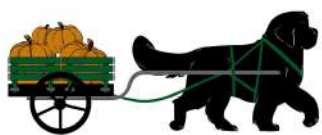

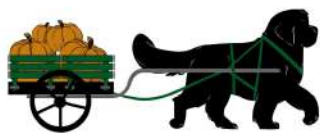

## Directions to Park:



### **North NJ via NJ Turnpike:**

- Take NJ Turnpike South to Exit 8 at Hightstown.
- Keep left to get on Route 133 West.
- Take Exit for 571 towards Princeton.
- Take first left onto Old Trenton Rd immediately after Route 133.
- Drive 3.4 miles and make a right onto Edinburg Rd.
- Mercer Park East is on the left.

### **South NJ via NJ Turnpike:**

*(Delaware)*

- Take NJ Turnpike North to Exit 7A.
- Follow West on I-195 to Exit 5B.
- Travel North on Route 130 to second traffic light (Route 33 and Route 526).
- Turn left at light, and stay in the right lane.
- Turn right onto Robbinsville Edinburg Rd.
- Continue until the road ends and turn right onto Mercerville-Edinburg Rd/Old Trenton Rd.
- Take first left onto Edinburg Rd.
- Mercer Park East is on the left.

### **Central/Western Pennsylvania:**

- Go East on PA Turnpike 276.
- Take Exit 351 to merge onto US-1 North.
- Keep right to stay on US-1 North. Enter NJ.
- Take the Whitehead Rd Exit. Keep right at the fork and merge onto Whitehead Rd.
- Turn left onto Sweetbriar Ave.
- Sweetbriar Ave turns into Sloan Ave, which then turns into Flock Rd, but continue straight.
- Turn left onto Edinburg Rd (Route 535).
- At third traffic light, turn left onto Edinburg Rd. (Go passed main entrance)
- Mercer Park East is on the left.

### **Central/Eastern NJ:**

- Use I-195 and head West.
- Take Exit 7 toward Washington and merge onto Route 526.
- Continue straight onto NJ Route 33. Stay in right lane.
- Use right lane to turn right onto Robbinsville Edinburg Rd.
- Continue until the road ends and turn right onto Mercerville-Edinburg Rd/Old Trenton Rd.
- Take first left onto Edinburg Rd.
- Mercer Park East is on the left.

### **South NJ via I-295:**

*(Delaware)*

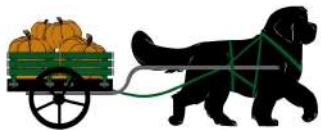
- Use I-295 North and take Exit 65A towards Sloan Ave East.
- Continue straight onto Sloan Ave. The road then becomes Flock Rd.
- Turn left onto Edinburg Rd (Route 535).
- At third traffic light, turn left onto Edinburg Rd. (Go passed main entrance)
- Mercer Park East is on the left.

### **Northern Pennsylvania:**

- Use I-476 South towards Philadelphia.
- Take the Exit onto I-276 East towards NJ.
- Take Exit 351 to merge onto US-1 North.
- Keep right to stay on US-1 North. Enter NJ.
- Take the Whitehead Rd Exit. Keep right at the fork and merge onto Whitehead Rd.
- Turn left onto Sweetbriar Ave.
- Sweetbriar Ave turns into Sloan Ave, which then turns into Flock Rd, but continue straight.
- Turn left onto Edinburg Rd (Route 535).
- At third traffic light, turn left onto Edinburg Rd. (Go passed main entrance)
- Mercer Park East is on the left.

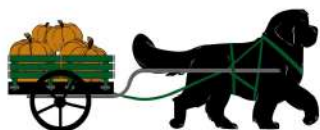
**IMPORTANT!!**
